Bullrock Solar Completes Construction of Two More Solar Fields Bringing a Combined 9MW of Energy to Residents in the Region.

Shelburne, VT-Gregg Beldock, CEO of the Bullrock Corporation and Bullrock Solar has announced that two recently completed solar fields in New York have begun generating energy. The sites include a ground mount solar array located in Catlin, New York. The 6MW solar array consists of over 17,000 solar panels and covers 24 acres of an under-utilized crop field. The Catlin site is providing energy for local community solar residential customers and is generating enough power to serve approximately 800 homes. The second site, located in Brunswick, NY, is a 3MW ground mount solar array. The solar field consists of 8,160 solar panels and covers 14 acres of under-utilized farmland, owned by The Hope United Methodist Church. It will provide energy for local community solar residential customers and generate enough power to serve approximately 400 homes. Gregg Beldock of Bullrock Corporation and Bullrock Solar said, “We are extremely excited about these solar fields in New York.” He goes on to say, “The completion of these sites will help make all the benefits of solar energy available to local community residents, who might otherwise not have had that opportunity.”
